If we have not received a call by 9.15 am then office staff will call your home to ensure everything is ok and ascertain the reason for absence. If we fail to receive an answer after a few tries staff may attempt a home visit. I am sure you will understand that this is done in the best interest of our pupils and families.

Can I also remind you that unless it is exceptional circumstances we cannot authorise term time holidays.

We will be holding a non-school uniform day on Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> July, with a donation of 50p, to raise money for a charity called CAMFED. This is a charity that raises money to support and give access education for girls in Africa who have been denied education. Raising money for this charity is important to us and continues our work fighting for women's right which links to our previous KS2 topic, The Suffragette's, who fought for women's rights and the right to an education. ## Well Done Foston Team


