## **Update on the School Meadow**

As you are aware the school meadow since September has become unusable following an infestation of chafer bugs and the damage done to it by crows and other mammals digging over the soil to feed on the grubs. After taking advice from contractors and local people who have experience in these issues the best policy was to leave the area for the crows and mammals to remove as many of the bugs as possible, as the grubs can remain in the soil for a number of years.

We have left the area for as long as we feel we possibly can before taking action. We have instructed the grounds maintenance contractor that we have, to clear, fill and roller the area so that we can start using the meadow after Easter.

Children will be asked to change into their trainers when they go over to the Meadow so please can you ensure that children have their trainers in school.
