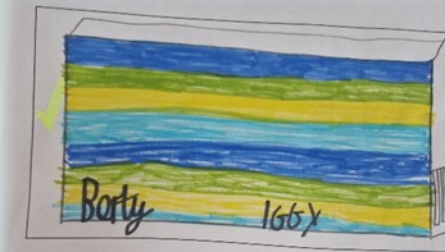


KS2 WOW WORK
