EYFS/KS1 WOW WORK

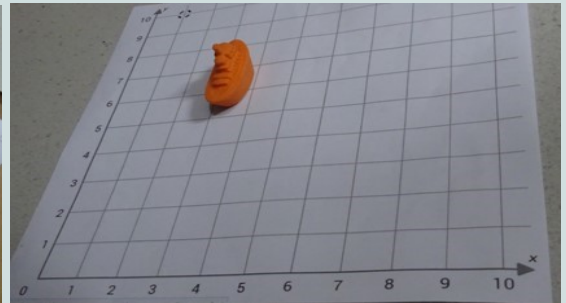
Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 have enjoyed observing their bean plants growing! We had a great time measuring how tall the they had grown!
