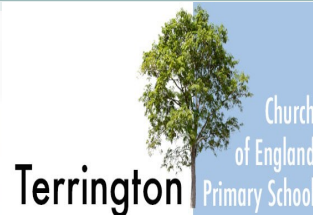

## **Sports Day**

On Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> July, all children from Nursery to Year 6 will be taking part in our sports day.

This will take place at Stillington Village Hall. Children from Terrington and Foston will be taken across by bus, which will depart at 9:00am.

**Parents and families are invited to join us from 1 o'clock** at Stillington Village hall and may take their children home with them when sports day has finished roughly around 2:30pm. Buses will still be provided for those children who need them and will return to school before the end of the school day.

All children are required to come in their PE kit: white t-shirt, black shorts or jogging bottoms and trainers. Children should also wear their school jumper/cardigan and bring their own, clearly named water bottle. Please can we also ask that pupils bring a sun hat and sun cream is applied before school (a labelled bottle can also be brought with them).

On this day, pupils are required to bring a packed lunch from home or already ordered from school.

**If you plan to attend, please feel free to bring your own chair!**

**Nursery children** who do not attend nursery on Tuesdays are also invited to join us. If your child would like to come for the day or the afternoon, please let the class teacher know.

## **Quidditch Day**

## **EYFS Trip To Askham Bryan Wildlife Park—July 12th**

We are pleased to be taking our EYFS children (Nursery and Reception), across the three schools, on a trip to Askham Bryan Wildlife park on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> July . They will be taking part in a ‘Habitats’ workshop focussing on animals that live in water following our current “Under the Sea” topic.

**The cost of the trip is £11 per child, this will be added to ParentPay.**

Please speak to the office if you have any additional circumstances that you wish to discuss. Please also ensure that you have given **permission for your child to go on the trips via ParentPay.**

**All children will need a packed lunch.** If you wish to **order a school, packed lunch**, please contact the office to order this **no later than June 22nd**. The choice of sandwich is tuna mayo, cheese or ham.

Please **drop your child off at 8.45am on this day** to ensure the timing of the trip is kept to and the day runs smoothly. Children will return to school by 3.15pm. They should wear school uniform as usual with sturdy and practical shoes and should bring a jacket and a water bottle, their packed lunch, along with a sunhat and sun cream (weather dependent).
