

## Tumblr.com

It has come to our notice, through our filtering and monitoring system at school that some children are trying to access 'Tumblr'.

Tumblr is a cross between WordPress and social media platforms like Facebook and Instagram, Tumblr gives users the ability to create blogs and share them with followers and friends across a number of social platforms.

While Tumblr's community guidelines warn against adult content, violence, hate speech and more, users could still come across these things. If this happens, users should report the content right away.

According to Tumblr's Terms of Service, the platform's general age minimum is 13. However, users in the European Union and United Kingdom must be at least 16 years old. Additionally, if users wish to use Tumblr's tipping feature, they must be 18 or older.

Tumblr is now blocked on all pupil devices in school. If your children have access to a phone, laptop, tablet or other computer, please check that the filters are correctly set to ensure your children cannot access sites that may give them access to inappropriate material.
