### NURSERY AND RECEPTION (EYFS) (CLASS 1)

This week the children have shown an interest in junk modelling, using recycled boxes to create a range of different sculptures. They have enjoyed painting them and experimenting with joining techniques such as gluing, stapling and taping. It has been lovely to see the children experiment and explore in such an artistic way.





#### KS1 (CLASS 2)

In class 2 this week, we were very lucky to have a wonderful drama session with Audrey. The children really enjoyed pretending to be different characters and then they interviewed their friends. One child was a Ninja Turtle and the other asked, 'Where did you get your shell?'. Another pair were unicorns and asked, 'How did you get your rainbow tail?' to which their partner replied, 'From magic land.' The fully immersed themselves in their role as a new character. You could try playing this game at home so they can show off their new acting skills!





#### KS2 (CLASS2)

This week we have been exploring the usefulness of the river Nile and what part it has played throughout history. We looked at the papyrus plant which grew along the river Nile and what uses it had. We explored how this was used to create paper that Egyptians used to write on. We created our own writing facts about the Nile and our own names using Egyptian Hieroglyphics.


