### Parents' Evening

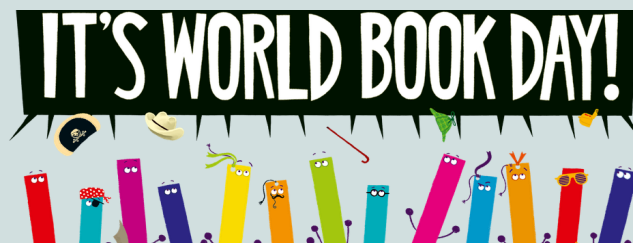

## NURSERY AND RECEPTION (EYFS) (CLASS 1)

This week the children have independently expanded their learning of farms by comparing it to a 'city'. I challenged the nursery children to compare the towers using the language of 'tall and short'.

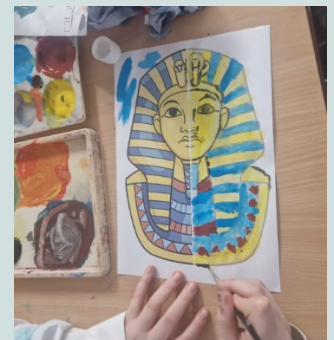
## KS1 (CLASS 2)

## **Nursey and Reception**

On the morning on **Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> March** the children in Nursery and Reception will be visiting Stillington Primary School to have a special visit from the 'Purple Pig Company'. 
Please find attached an informative wall poster that serves to reinforce online safety practices and encourages open conversations among young people, parents, caregivers, and colleagues.
