Financial Assistance

You may be eligible to apply for free school meals if you receive one of the following incomerelated benefits. Even though your child may already receive them now if they are in Years Reception, Year 1 or Year 2, it is worth applying as children who are recorded as eligible for free school meals will continue with free school meals for 6 years (referred to as Ever 6FSM).

Income Support

Income-based Job Seekers' Allowance

Income-related Employment and Support Allowance

Child Tax Credit combined with both a household income below £16,190 per annum and not in receipt of any Working Tax Credit.

Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999




We will be conducting these questionnaires over this month with the following year groups:


This exciting event will take place on Wednesday 15^h May at Terrington school. All the children need are their PE kits.






KS2 (CLASS 3)
