This week, children in Class 1 have enjoyed exploring the provision areas including the sand and water trays, and outside activities, in the better weather.

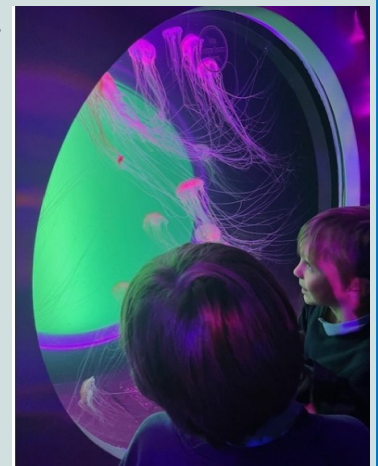


## KS1 (CLASS 2)

## KS2 (CLASS 3)
