

Dear Parents,

Please can we remind all parents to follow the NHS guidance relating to childhood infections. As a school we follow the NHS guidance for illness within school.

<u>UKHSA guidance</u> (Oct 2023) says that it is not recommended that children and young people

are tested for COVID-19 unless directed to by a health professional.

For children and young people aged 18 and under who are recommended to take a COVID-19 test by a health professional and test positive, the advice is to try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for three days. This is because children and young people tend to be infectious to other people for less time than adults.

Please be aware that we do have vulnerable children within our school community and appreciate if parents could let us know as soon as possible if their child has any infectious illnesses. In this way we can notify the parents in a timely manner. Thank you for your help in this matter.


